



PAESANO'S RESTAURANT HONORS FR. ADDARI WITH RECOGNITION DINNER

CHELSEA – On Monday June 20, 2011, Michael and Bridget Roddy, owners of Paesano's Restaurant in Ann Arbor, MI, created an Abruzzi style dinner to honor Fr. Enzo Addari, Administrator of St. Louis Center in Chelsea. Limited to fifty people, the concept was to create a special dinner consisting of food & wine from Fr. Enzo's home area of Corcumello, Abruzzi, with proceeds going to support St. Louis Center. Those in attendance were not disappointed, as the meal consisted of a typical Italian meal of antipasto salad, a garden salad, a primo course of pasta with sauce, and a secondo course of lamb and Italian sausage, served on a bed of polenta, followed by dolce, (dessert). The meal also included two different white and red wines to match the food that was served.

Most important, were the friends of Fr. Enzo who came to honor him that night with their good wishes and prayers of support for St. Louis Center. A total of eight people came forward to share their "Fr. Enzo stories," and the prevailing theme was their admiration for his work ethic and his spirituality. For gifts, Fr.
